In the event that water is shut off for non-payment; a service charge of \$50.00 will be paid before water is turned on. If water is turned on after hours, a service charge of \$100.00 will be paid before water is turned on.

Late fees will be assessed quarterly on overdue bills. The schedule is as follows:

1 unit:	\$20.00
2 units:	\$25.00
3 units:	\$30.00
4 units:	\$35.00
5 units:	\$40.00
6 units:	\$45.00
7 units or greater:	\$50.00

A fee of \$25.00 will be charged if it is necessary to send a shut-off notice by certified mail. Three shut-off notices will be mailed. The third shut-off notice will be mailed by certified mail.

A fee of \$25.00 will be charged for all returned checks (checks received with insufficient funds).

Each October liens will be placed on properties with overdue bills, in which water service has not been shut off. A lien fee of \$50.00 will be charged to the account.

If advisable, the District will lay service pipe to the curbstop or where there is not, to within four feet of line of street; all expense inside of it shall be borne by the owner or taker supplied, as well as any damage that may occur within said lines. A connection fee in the amount of the actual cost to the District will be charged to the property owner for all District connections.

The District will, upon the written request of a customer, test a meter for accuracy. If a meter is found to be inaccurate by more than two percent, no charge shall be made for such test and the customer's bill for the quarter in which such test is made and for the next proceeding quarter only shall be equitable adjusted to correct for such inaccuracy. If the meter is found to be correct or to be inaccurate by no more than two percent, no adjustment shall be made and the customer requesting the test shall reimburse the District for the cost of the test and shall pay a service charge in the amount of \$75.00

If it is determined that a meter has been tampered with, a fee of \$1000.00 will be charged for the 1st offense. Water service will be shut off for a second offense.

When a meter needs to be replaced due to meter upgrades or a broken meter, a letter will be mailed to the property owner asking that an appointment be made for the meter change. If the property owner fails to make and/or keep the appointment, a fee of \$50.00 will be charged every quarter until the meter is replaced.
